Athletics Camp Terms and Conditions

Effective Date: 1 May 2026

These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) govern all bookings and participation in athletics camps operated by **Leevale Athletic Club** (“the Club”, “we”, “us”, “our”). By completing a booking and/or allowing a child to participate in a camp, the parent or legal guardian agrees to be bound by these Terms.

For the purposes of this agreement, all children attending camp are referred to as “**Participants.**” The person completing the booking is referred to as the “**Parent/Guardian.**”

1. Acceptance of Terms

1.1 By completing a booking (online, telephone, or otherwise) and/or making payment, you confirm that:

- You are the Parent/Guardian of the Participant(s) listed in the booking.
- You have authority to accept these Terms on behalf of the Participant(s).
- You agree to be legally bound by these Terms.

1.2 Payment constitutes acceptance of these Terms.

1.3 You cannot complete a booking unless these Terms are accepted.

2. Eligibility

2.1 Participants must:

- Be **6 years of age or older.**
- Be attending primary school at the time of the camp.

2.2 The Club reserves the right to request proof of age if required.

3. Booking and Payment

3.1 Places are allocated on a **first-come, first-served basis.**

3.2 Any sibling discount applies **only to siblings from the same family.**

3.3 The Club reserves the right to refuse or cancel any booking at its discretion.

4. Cancellations and Refunds

4.1 Cancellations by Parent/Guardian

- Cancellations made **more than 7 days prior** to the camp start date are eligible for a refund.
- Cancellations made **within 7 days** of the camp start date are **not eligible for a refund**.

4.2 Cancellations by Leevale Athletic Club

The Club reserves the right to:

- Cancel a camp,
- Amend dates,
- Modify activities,
- Cancel individual days,

due to unforeseen circumstances including (but not limited to): adverse weather, force majeure, war, strike, riot, crime, pandemic, flood, earthquake, or any event beyond our reasonable control.

In such cases, the Club will determine, at its discretion, whether a refund or credit is appropriate. The Club shall not be liable for any indirect or consequential losses arising from such cancellation or amendment.

5. Conduct and Discipline

5.1 Participants must:

- Follow all instructions from coaches and staff.
- Remain with their assigned group at all times.
- Treat fellow Participants, coaches, staff, and volunteers with respect.
- Refrain from bullying, discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or inappropriate behaviour.
- Not use rude or abusive language.
- Not intentionally cause physical or emotional harm.
- Not interfere with others' personal belongings.
- Treat all equipment and facilities with care.
- Not bring or use mobile phones at the venue.

5.2 Any Participant whose behaviour is deemed by the **Head Coach or Camp Managers** to be detrimental to the camp may be suspended or dismissed immediately.
No refund will be provided in such circumstances.

5.3 Parents/Guardians must treat Coaches and staff with courtesy and professionalism.
Disrespectful or aggressive behaviour towards staff will not be tolerated.

6. Supervision and Collection

6.1 The Club is not responsible for Participants:

- More than **15 minutes before** camp start time.
- More than **15 minutes after** camp finish time.

6.2 Parents/Guardians must ensure timely drop-off and collection.

6.3 Parents/Guardians must not enter the camp venue during camp hours without prior arrangement with the Head Coach.

7. Health, Safety and Risk Acknowledgement

7.1 Athletics and sports activities involve inherent risks, including risk of personal injury.

7.2 By accepting these Terms, the Parent/Guardian:

- Acknowledges the inherent risks associated with participation.
- Consents to the Participant taking part in all scheduled camp activities.
- Accepts those risks on behalf of the Participant.

7.3 The Club operates to high health and safety standards and maintains public liability insurance.

7.4 The Club shall not be liable for any illness, injury, loss, damage, or death unless caused by the **proven negligence** of the Club or its staff.

7.5 The Parent/Guardian is responsible for arranging **personal accident insurance** for the Participant.

7.6 To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Parent/Guardian:

- Releases and indemnifies Leevale Athletic Club from claims arising from participation in camp activities, except where caused by proven negligence of the Club.

8. Medical Consent

8.1 The Parent/Guardian grants permission for the Club to:

- Administer basic first aid where required.
- Seek professional medical treatment in the event of injury or illness.
- Contact emergency services if necessary.

8.2 Any medical conditions, allergies, or special requirements must be disclosed at the time of booking.

9. Food and Personal Belongings

9.1 The Club does **not provide lunches or water**. Participants must bring:

- Sufficient food,
- Adequate hydration,
- Appropriate clothing for weather conditions.

9.2 The Club recommends that Participants **do not bring valuables**.

9.3 The Club is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.

9.4 Lost property may not be retained or returned.

10. Photography and Media

10.1 Photographs and video footage may be taken during camp for promotional purposes.

10.2 By accepting these Terms, the Parent/Guardian:

- Acknowledges that all such material is the property of Leevale Athletic Club.
- Consents to its use in promotional materials, including the Club's website and social media platforms.

10.3 If a Parent/Guardian does not consent to media use, written notice must be provided prior to camp commencement.

11. Privacy and Data Protection

11.1 The Club processes personal data in accordance with its Privacy Policy, available at:

11.2 By completing a booking, the Parent/Guardian consents to the collection and processing of personal data for the purposes of camp administration and communication.

11.3 The Club shall not be responsible for failure to receive communications due to incorrect contact details or spam/junk email filtering.

12. Programme Changes

12.1 The Club reserves the right to:

- Modify the camp programme,
- Substitute activities,
- Adjust schedules,

where necessary due to operational, safety, or weather considerations.

13. Limitation of Liability

13.1 To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Club shall not be liable for:

- Indirect or consequential loss,
- Loss of opportunity,
- Travel or accommodation costs,
- Loss arising from cancellation due to circumstances beyond the Club's control.

13.2 Nothing in these Terms excludes liability where it would be unlawful to do so.

14. Force Majeure

The Club shall not be liable for failure or delay in performing its obligations where such failure results from events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to weather events, government restrictions, pandemics, strikes, or other force majeure events.

15. Governing Law

15.1 These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the **Republic of Ireland**.

15.2 Any dispute arising in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Republic of Ireland.

16. Severability

If any provision of these Terms is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

17. Entire Agreement

These Terms constitute the entire agreement between the Parent/Guardian and Leevale Athletic Club in respect of the Athletics Camp and supersede all prior discussions, representations, or agreements.
